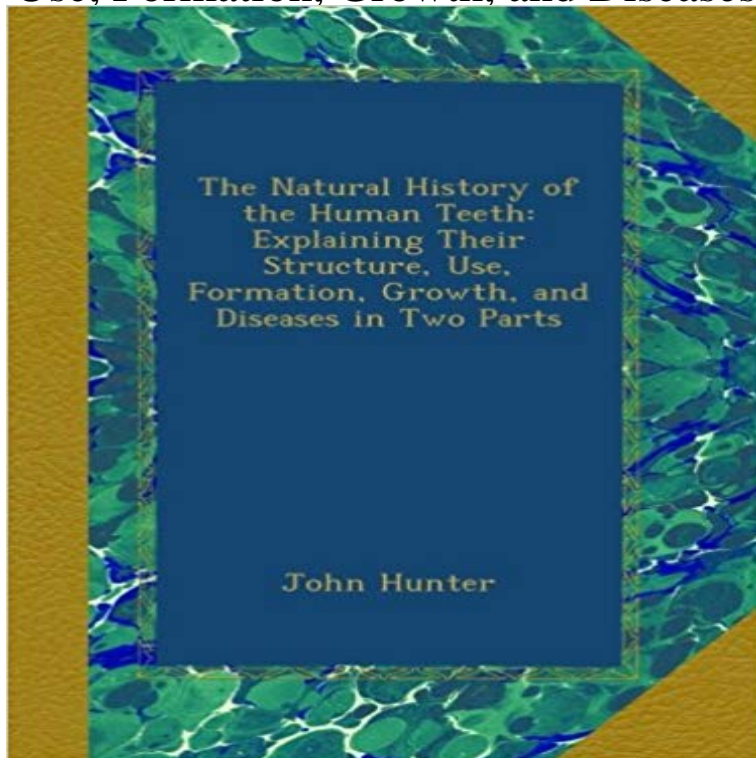


# The Natural History of the Human Teeth: Explaining Their Structure, Use, Formation, Growth, and Diseases in Two Parts
