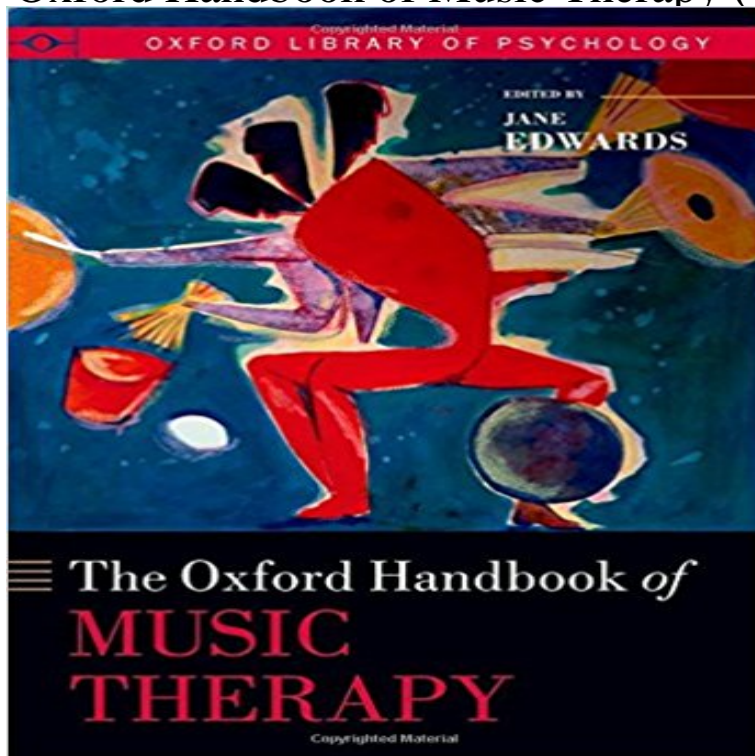


Oxford Handbook of Music Therapy (Oxford Handbooks)
